At a regular session of the County Commission of Cabell County, West Virginia, held at the Courthouse thereof, on the 26th day of May, 2016, the following Order was made and entered:

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CABELL COUNTY COMMISSION'S
ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING, MAINTAINING AND OPERATING A
COUNTYWIDE ENHANCED EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM (E911)
TO INCREASE THE FEE UPON LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE
CONSUMERS TO FINANCE ITS MAINTENANCE**

WHEREAS: The County Commission of Cabell County, West Virginia, having heretofore adopted an Ordinance for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a Countywide Enhanced Emergency Telephone System (E-911) and desiring to amend said plan hereinafter set forth, does hereby adopt the following amendment(s) to said ordinance:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:


- Page 8, Section 12 – Imposition of Fee (a), **delete:** Pursuant to Section § 7-1-3cc of the West Virginia Code, the Cabell County Commission shall impose a fee of \$6.50 per month per local business exchange service line and \$ 4.50 per month, per local residential service line, including voice-over-internet protocol and digital service, to finance the projected costs of establishing, equipping, furnishing, and maintaining the Enhanced Emergency Telephone System. Said fee shall be effective immediately upon implementation of fee by all competitive local exchange carriers and other carriers whose subscribers are responsible of paying a fee pursuant to West Virginia Code § 7-1-3cc. Tel-e-assistance services shall be exempt from the fee imposed by this section.
- Page 8, Section 12 – Imposition of Fee (a), **add:** Pursuant to Section § 7-1-3cc of the West Virginia Code, the Cabell County Commission shall impose a fee of \$9.50 per month per local business exchange service line and \$7.00 per month, per local residential service line, including voice-over-internet protocol and digital service, to finance the projected costs of establishing, equipping, furnishing, and maintaining the Enhanced Emergency Telephone System. Said fee shall be effective immediately upon implementation of fee by all competitive local exchange carriers and other carriers whose subscribers are responsible of paying a fee pursuant to West Virginia Code § 7-1-3cc. Tel-e-assistance services shall be exempt from the fee imposed by this section.
- Page 8, Section 12 – Imposition of Fee (b), **delete:** To equalize the rate charged to PBX and Centrex systems, PBX and Centrex lines will be charged at the rate of \$6.50 per line per month. The fee for Centrex and PBX and similar systems shall be \$6.50 per line per month for the first sixteen lines and at the rate of one eighth of \$6.50 per month for all additional lines.
- Page 8, Section 12 – Imposition of Fee (b), **add:** To equalize the rate charged to PBX and Centrex systems, PBX and Centrex lines will be charged at the rate of \$9.50 per line per month. The fee for Centrex and PBX and similar systems shall be \$9.50 per line per month for the first sixteen lines and at the rate of one eighth of \$9.50 per month for all additional lines.
