At a regular session of the County Commission of Wayne County, West Virginia, held at the Courthouse thereof, on the 11th day of June, 2018, the following Order was made and entered:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE WAYNE COUNTY COMMISSION'S ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING, MAINTAINING AND OPERATING A COUNTYWIDE ENHANCED EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM (E911) TO INCREASE THE FEE UPON LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE CONSUMERS TO FINANCE ITS MAINTENANCE

WHEREAS: The County Commission of Wayne County, West Virginia, having heretofore adopted an Ordinance for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a Countywide Enhanced Emergency Telephone System (E-911) and desiring to amend said plan hereinafter set forth, does hereby adopt the following amendment(s) to said ordinance:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- Page 6, Section 5 – Project of Cost (1), **delete:** The imposition, pursuant to section three-cc article one, chapter 7 (7-1-1-cc) of the West Virginia Code, of a two dollar (\$2.00) per month per local exchange service line or line equivalent, except for tel-assistance lines, is proposed to finance the projected costs of the enhanced emergency telephone system. Such fee is proposed to be reduced when the capital and installation costs have been recovered to offset recurring operational, maintenance and dispatcher costs only. Such fee is not proposed to be used to offset the costs associated with establishing, equipping, furnishing, operating or maintaining of the county answering point(s). Such fee is proposed to become effective August 27, 1996
- Page 6, Section 5 – Project of Cost (1), **add:** The imposition, pursuant to section three-cc article one, chapter 7 (7-1-1-cc) of the West Virginia Code, of a four dollar (\$4.00) per month per local exchange service line or line equivalent, except for tel-assistance lines, is proposed to finance the projected costs of the enhanced emergency telephone system. Such fee is proposed to be reduced when the capital and installation costs have been recovered to offset recurring operational, maintenance and dispatcher costs only. Such fee is not proposed to be used to offset the costs associated with establishing,

equipping, furnishing, operating or maintaining of the county answering point(s). Such fee is proposed to become effective August 1, 2018.
