

JOINT COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR OPERATION OF E-911  
EMERGENCY TELEPHONE CENTERS

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 26<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2001, by and between the WETZEL COUNTY COMMISSION and the TYLER COUNTY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the Wetzel County Commission and the Tyler County Commission desire to provide for the efficient and effective operation of their respective E-911 Emergency Telephone Communication Centers in Wetzel and Tyler County, West Virginia; and,

WHEREAS, the municipality of Paden City is geographically situate in both Wetzel and Tyler Counties, West Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the Wetzel County Commission and the Tyler County Commission have determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of the municipality of Paden City, regardless of which county they reside in, to be served by the E-911 Emergency Telephone Communication Center operated by the Wetzel County Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows, to-wit:

1) All residents of the municipality of Paden City will be served by the Wetzel County E-911 Emergency Telephone Communication Center regardless of the county in which said citizen resides.


**AMENDMENT TO THE WETZEL COUNTY ENHANCED 911 COUNTY ORDINANCE**


WHEREAS, all residents of the municipality of Paden City will be served by The Wetzel County E-911 Emergency Telephone Communication Center regardless of the County in which said citizen resides.


The purpose of the Amendment to the Wetzel County Enhanced 911 County Ordinance is for the Wetzel County E-911 call center to serve all citizens residing within the municipal boundary of Paden City, WV with E-911 emergency call service regardless of whether they reside in Wetzel or Tyler County.

2) The Tyler County Commission hereby grants unto the Wetzel County Commission full power and authority to make any and all necessary arrangements with the Public Service Commission, telephone companies, utility companies, individuals, or any other entity in order to provide E-911 services to the Municipality of Paden City as set forth in this Agreement.

3) All E-911 fees for residents of Paden City located within Wetzel County shall continue to be collected by the Wetzel County Commission.

4) All E-911 fees for residents of Paden City located within <sup>Wetzel</sup> Tyler County shall continue to be collected by the Tyler County Commission.

5) The Wetzel County commission shall assume full responsibility for maintaining an effective E-911 system for all residents of the municipality of Paden City.

6) The Tyler County Commission shall pay an annual fee of Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100 (\$250.00) Dollars to the Wetzel County Commission for providing E-911 service to the Tyler County residents of Paden City. Said fee shall be payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August of each year commencing on August 1, 2001.

7) All costs and expenses incurred in converting Paden City, Tyler County residents to the Wetzel County E-911 Emergency Telephone Communication Center shall be equally paid by the Tyler County Commission and the Wetzel County Commission.


8) In the event this agreement is held to be invalid by the Public Service Commission or the Tyler County Commission is prohibited from receiving the E-911 fees of Paden City, Tyler County residents for any reason, this agreement shall be terminated and all costs and expenses incurred in converting Paden City, Tyler County residents back to the Tyler County E-911 Emergency Telephone Communication Center shall be equally paid by the Tyler County Commission and the Wetzel County Commission.

9) Either party to this Agreement may terminate the same any time upon ninety (90) days written notice to the other party. In the event of such termination all costs and expenses incurred in converting Paden City, Tyler County residents back to the Tyler County E-911 Emergency Telephone Communication Center shall be paid by the party exercising the right of termination.

10) The parties agree to amend their respective E-911 "final plans" in accordance with West Virginia Code 24-6-6(e).
