PSC Confirms Felman Special Rate for Electricity

The Public Service Commission of West Virginia today issued an order that denied two petitions for reconsideration of its April 3, 2014 Order awarding Felman Production, LLC a special rate for electricity from Appalachian Power Company (APCo). The petitions for reconsideration were filed by the Commission's Consumer Advocate Division (CAD) and the West Virginia Energy Users Group (WVEUG).

In August 2013, Felman petitioned the Commission to establish a special rate for it to purchase electricity. The Commission approved a modified version of that proposal in an April 3, 2014 Order. CAG and WVEUG petitioned the Commission to reconsider that decision based on several issues. Today's Order denied the petitions of CAD and WVEUG and states that the April 3, 2014 Order remains in full force and effect.

The April 3, 2014 Order stated if Felman chose to accept the Approved Rate, APCo and Felman were to enter into a contract, which is to be filed with the Commission by June 30, 2014.
