## **PSC to Hold Public Comment Hearing in Webster Springs on West Virginia American Water Cases**

CHARLESTON, WV – The Public Service Commission of West Virginia will hold a public comment hearing on two pending cases filed by West Virginia-American Water Company on Wednesday, October 25, 2017, in the Municipal Building at 146 McGraw Avenue, Webster Springs.

West Virginia-American has proposed that the Webster Springs Treatment Plant be decommissioned and that an interconnection be constructed so that customers who are now served by the Webster Springs Treatment Plant can be served by the Weston Treatment Plant. The total estimated cost of this project is \$20.8 million. In its DSIC case, the Company proposes to invest \$29.9 million in its infrastructure during calendar year 2018. This includes cost recovery for the certificate project, with revised rates to become effective January 1, 2018.

The evidentiary hearing for these cases began on October 11, 2017.
