## PSC Enforcement Officer Receives National Award

CHARLESTON, WV – The Public Service Commission of West Virginia today announced that Special Operations and Eastern Section Manager Reggie Bunner had been awarded the Law Enforcement Appreciation Award for 2019 by the Cooperative Hazardous Materials Enforcement Development Program (COHMED). The award was presented to Bunner at the annual COHMED Conference in San Antonio, Texas.

COHMED, a program of the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance, is an international organization committed to improving hazardous materials transportation safety by fostering uniformity in regulation and enforcement, sharing information on hazardous materials transportation issues and providing technical assistance to states and local governments to develop and enhance programs to improve hazardous materials safety. COHMED provides advanced hazardous materials (hazmat) and dangerous goods training to regulatory and enforcement inspectors.
