

- I. Rules and Regulations for the government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

STEP 2

(Effective on and after September 21, 2018, until January 1, 2019)

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire area served.

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial and sale for resale water service.

(D) **RATES**

Service Charge (based upon meter size)

5/8 inch meter	\$ 4.63 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 6.94 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 11.57 per month
1½ inch meter	\$ 23.13 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 37.00 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 74.00 per month
4 inch meter	\$115.63 per month

Usage Charge:

\$8.14 per thousand gallons of water used per month

(D) **SALES FOR RESALE RATE**

All water for resale will be billed in accordance with the approved rate of \$8.14 per 1,000 gallons of water used per month.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all current usage billings not paid when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

STEP 2 (Continued)

TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant:

A tap fee of \$300.00 will be charged to customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

RECONNECTION

\$15.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of water

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provisions.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$5.51 per M Gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District, not to exceed \$25.00, will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by his or her bank due to insufficient funds.


