

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

SCHEDULE I

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within entire territory served, excluding the area formerly served by Justice Public Service District.

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial and sale for resale water service.

RATES (customers with metered water supply)

All usage \$13.90 per 1,000 gallons per month

MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts, according to meter size:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 27.80 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 41.70 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 69.50 per month
1- 1/4 inch meter	\$ 101.61 per month
1- 1/2 inch meter	\$ 139.00 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 222.40 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 417.00 per month
4 inch meter	\$ 695.00 per month
6 inch meter	\$ 1,390.00 per month
8 inch meter	\$ 1,224.00 per month

RESALE RATE

All water for resale to the Town of Delbarton will be billed in accordance to the approved rate of \$4.72 per 1,000 gallons used per month. All water for resale to Crum Public Service District and Town of Kermit will be billed in accordance to the approved rate of \$3.41 per 1,000 gallons used per month.

SCHEDULE I (Continued)

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

RECONNECTION CHARGE

\$20.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of water

TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$100.00 will be charged to customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. This pre-construction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to the applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of \$350.00 will be charged to customers applying for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$1.65 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when a bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical usage.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the utility up to a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by the bank due to insufficient funds.

SCHEDULE I (Continued)

TRANSPORTATION CREDIT

A credit of \$0.148 per 1,000 gallons exiting the Town of Delbarton's water system will be issued by the District on the bill rendered for the Town's purchased water for its cost of pumping and transporting the District's water through the Town's system.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

A deposit of \$50.00 or two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, whichever is greater.

FIRE PROTECTION FEE

Where connections, hydrants, sprinklers, etc. on private property are maintained by customer:

These terms are payable in advance.

RATE

Each municipality shall pay an annual public fire service charge of \$274.00 per year per fire hydrant payable in twelve (12) monthly payments.

Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial service.

1 inch meter	\$ 65.20 per month
1 - 1/2 inch meter	\$130.40 per month
2 inch meter	\$208.64 per month

**DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY**

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where appropriate.

**TAP FEE**

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$250.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

(I) **RECONNECTION FEE**

\$25.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills or fraudulent use of water

(I) **LEAK ADJUSTMENT**

\$5.71 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

(N) **RETURNED CHECK CHARGE**

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the water utility up to a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by the bank due to insufficient funds.

**SECURITY DEPOSIT**

A deposit of \$50.00 or two-twelfths (2/12) of the average usage of the applicant's specific customer class, whichever is greater.

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
