RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

**STEP 2**  
(Effective after 24 months)

**APPLICABILITY**

Applicable within the entire territory served

**AVAILABILITY**

Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial and sale for resale water service

(D) **RATES** (customers with metered water supply)

First 2,000 gallons used per month	\$12.88 per 1,000 gallons
Over 2,000 gallons used per month	\$12.88 per 1,000 gallons

(D) **MINIMUM CHARGE**

No bill will be rendered for less than the following, based upon meter size:

5/8 -inch meter	\$ 25.76 per month
3/4 -inch meter	\$ 38.64 per month
1 -inch meter	\$ 64.40 per month
1 - 1/2 -inch meter	\$128.80 per month
2 -inch meter	\$206.80 per month
3 -inch meter	\$386.40 per month

**TAP FEE**

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$250.00 will be charged to customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. This pre-construction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of \$350.00 will be charged to customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

**STEP 2** (Continued)

**RECONNECTION - \$25.00**

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills or fraudulent use of water

**DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY**

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

**LEAK ADJUSTMENT INCREMENT**

\$2.04 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

**RETURNED CHECK CHARGE**

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District up to a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by the bank due to insufficient funds.

**SECURITY DEPOSIT**

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provision.
