RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

STEP 2

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial and sale for resale water service.

- (D) **RATES** (customers with metered water supply)
\$10.79 per 1,000 gallons used per month

- (D) **MINIMUM CHARGE**

No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts according to the size of the meter serving the customer:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 30.90 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 46.35 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 77.25 per month
1 - 1/2 inch meter	\$ 154.50 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 247.20 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 494.40 per month
4 inch meter	\$ 772.50 per month
6 inch meter	\$1,545.00 per month
8 inch meter	\$2,472.00 per month

- (D) The above minimum is subject to an additional \$0.49 per thousand gallons of water used per month.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above tariff is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

STEP 2 (Continued)

TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an Applicant.

A tap fee of \$100.00 will be charged to all customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. This preconstruction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an Applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of \$300.00 will be charged to customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$2.94 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption, which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

RECONNECTION FEE

\$25.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, nonpayment of bills, or fraudulent use of water

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District, not to exceed \$25.00, will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by his or her bank due to insufficient funds.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provisions.
