

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

STEP 1

(Effective for all service rendered on and after the date this Order becomes
final for 24 months)

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial and sale for resale water
service.

(I) **RATES** (Customers with a metered water supply)

First	2,000 gallons used per month	\$16.88 per 1,000 gallons
Next	3,000 gallons used per month	\$14.55 per 1,000 gallons
Next	5,000 gallons used per month	\$13.81 per 1,000 gallons
Next	10,000 gallons used per month	\$13.01 per 1,000 gallons
Over	20,000 gallons used per month	\$11.48 per 1,000 gallons

(I) **MINIMUM CHARGE**

No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts according to the size of
the meter installed:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 33.76 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 50.64 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 84.40 per month
1 - 1/4 inch meter	\$ 123.22 per month
1 - 1/2 inch meter	\$ 168.80 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 270.08 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 540.16 per month
4 inch meter	\$ 844.00 per month
6 inch meter	\$1,688.00 per month
8 inch meter	\$2,700.80 per month

(I) **FLAT RATE CHARGE**

Equivalent of 4,500 gallons of water usage \$70.14 per month.

STEP 1 (Continued)

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

TAP FEE

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$100.00 will be charged to customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. This pre-construction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of \$350 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

RECONNECTION CHARGE \$25.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violation of rules, non-payment of bills or fraudulent use of water

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District or a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by his or her bank due to insufficient funds.

(I) **LEAK ADJUSTMENT**

\$4.46 per 1,000 gallon is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above customer's historical average usage.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or fifty dollars (\$50.00), whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provisions.



STEP 2

(Effective for all service rendered 24 months after the date this Order becomes final)

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial and sale for resale water service.

(D) **RATES** (Customers with a metered water supply)

First	2,000 gallons used per month	\$15.81 per 1,000 gallons
Next	3,000 gallons used per month	\$13.63 per 1,000 gallons
Next	5,000 gallons used per month	\$12.94 per 1,000 gallons
Next	10,000 gallons used per month	\$12.20 per 1,000 gallons
Over	20,000 gallons used per month	\$10.76 per 1,000 gallons

(D) **MINIMUM CHARGE**

No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts according to the size of the meter installed:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 31.62 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 47.43 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 79.05 per month
1 - 1/4 inch meter	\$ 115.41 per month
1 - 1/2 inch meter	\$ 158.10 per month
