RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

(C) AVAILABILITY

Available for domestic, commercial, industrial (except unusual industrial waste) sewer service.

(I,C) RATES (Customers with a metered water supply)

Residential \$13.65 per 1,000 gallons

(C,I) MINIMUM CHARGE (Customers with a metered water supply)

Each residential customer shall pay a minimum charge of \$27.30 per month (Equivalent of 3,000 gallons of water usage)

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the sewer utility up to a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customers whose check for payment of charges is returned by the bank due to insufficient funds.

RECONNECTION CHARGE

\$25.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills, of fraudulent use of water.

TAP FEES

A tap fee of \$400.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

(I) LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$3.37 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when a bill reflects unusual water consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed one-sixth (1/6) of the annual estimated charge for residential service or \$50.00, whichever is greater or one-sixth (1/6) of the annual estimated charge for commercial service.
