

(I) **MINIMUM MONTHLY BILL**

No monthly minimum water bill (metered or non-metered) shall be rendered for less than Forty-Two and 06/100 (\$42.06) Dollars.

CUSTOMER DEPOSIT

All new applicants for residential or other water service may be required to deposit (i) a minimum of fifty dollars (\$50), or (ii) two-twelfths (2/12) of the annual estimated charge for water service, whichever is greater.

CUSTOMER DEPOSIT (Continued)

All new applicants for residential or other combined water and sewer service may be required to deposit (i) a minimum of one hundred dollars (\$100), or (ii) two-twelfths(2/12) of the annual estimated charge for each service, whichever is greater.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net and on all current accounts not paid in full within twenty (20) days of date of bill, a ten percent (10%) surcharge will be added to the next amount shown.

If any bill is not paid within sixty (60) days after date, water service to the customer will be discontinued. Water service will not be restored until all past due water and sewer bills have been paid in full and all accrued penalties plus a reconnection charge have been paid.

RECONNECTION

A fee of \$30.00 will be charged to all customers who have had service discontinued for non-payment of their account or for any other violation in accordance with rules of the Public Service Commission, before service will be instituted again.

(I) **WATER TAP FEE**

A fee of Four Hundred Fifty (\$450.00) Dollars shall be charged for the installation of each new water tap.

MULTIPLE OCCUPANCY

On apartment buildings, or other multiple occupancy buildings, bills will be rendered based on each family or business unit located therein paying not less than the minimum monthly charge herein established for a one inch meter, the minimum bill for the size of meter installed, or the actual charge for water used, whichever is greater. Motels and hotels shall pay according to the size of meter installed.

TRAILER COURTS

House trailer courts shall be provided with a master meter. No bill shall be rendered for less than the minimum bill herein established for a one inch meter, multiplied by the number of units situated on the court site at the time the meter is read, the minimum bill for the size meter installed, or the actual charge for water used, whichever is greater. House trailers (as used hereinabove) shall include both mobile and immobile units.

House trailers, either mobile or immobile, located on sites other than a park or court, shall be billed in the same manner as any other family or business unit.

SWIMMING POOLS

Effective on the 1st day of February, 1996, all customers of the Paden City Water System who own a swimming pool, will pay the following rates for each fill up.

The swimming pool fee shall be in addition to regular water usage rates, shall be payable in full in the month the fill up is made, and will be charged to all customers who own a swimming pool.
