

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

SCHEDULE I

APPLICABILITY

Applicable in entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial service.

(I) RATES (Customers with metered water supply)

First	2,000	gallons used per month	\$14.64 per 1,000 gallons
Next	8,000	gallons used per month	\$14.22 per 1,000 gallons
Next	25,000	gallons used per month	\$13.43 per 1,000 gallons
Next	25,000	gallons used per month	\$12.64 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	60,000	gallons used per month	\$12.22 per 1,000 gallons

(I) MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts, according to the size of the meter installed, to-wit:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 29.28 per 1,000 gallons
1 inch meter	\$ 73.20 per 1,000 gallons
2 inch meter	\$234.24 per 1,000 gallons
3 inch meter	\$468.48 per 1,000 gallons
4 inch meter	\$731.99 per 1,000 gallons

MULTIPLE OCCUPANCY

On apartment buildings or other multiple occupancy buildings, each family or business unit shall be required to pay not less than the minimum monthly charge herein established for a five-eighths inch (5/8") meter. Motels and hotels shall pay according to the size of meter installed.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the Town of Lumberport or a minimum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

SCHEDULE I (Continued)

DELAYED PAYMENT CHARGE

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. The delayed payment penalty is not interest and is only to be collected once for each bill where it is appropriate.

RECONNECTION

\$25.00 to be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violation of rules, non-payment of bills or fraudulent use of water.

TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant. A tap fee of \$350.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service for each new tap to the system.

(I) LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$3.85 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

A refundable deposit of \$50.00 shall be required of all residential, commercial and industrial customers. Said deposit will be refunded with interest (at a rate provided annually by the Public Service Commission) after 12 consecutive months of on time payments, or in the case of tenant when said tenant discontinues water service and vacates premises per 4.2.a.4. Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the annual estimated charge for residential service or one-sixth (1/6) of the annual estimated charge for commercial service.

TRAILER COURTS

When house trailer courts are provided with a master meter, no bill shall be rendered for less than twenty-four dollars and forty cents multiplies by the number of units situated on the court site at the time the meter is read or the actual charge for the size meter installed, whichever is greater. House trailer (as used herein above) shall include both mobile and immobile units. House trailers, either mobile or immobile, located on sites other than a park or court, shall be billed in the same manner as any other family or business unit.
