

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

SCHEDULE I

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within entire service territory served, with the exception of the Jones Run area.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial water service.

RATES (customers with metered water supply)

First	3,000 gallons used per month	\$12.04 per 1,000 gallons
Next	3,000 gallons used per month	\$11.69 per 1,000 gallons
Next	4,000 gallons used per month	\$11.13 per 1,000 gallons
Next	15,000 gallons used per month	\$10.64 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	25,000 gallons used per month	\$ 9.03 per 1,000 gallons

MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than the following, according to the size of the meter installed:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 36.12 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 54.16 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 90.26 per month
1 1/2 inch meter	\$ 180.52 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 288.84 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 577.66 per month
4 inch meter	\$ 902.61 per month
6 inch meter	\$1,805.21 per month

SCHEDULE II

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the Jones Run area.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general domestic, commercial, and industrial water service

RATES (customers with metered water supply)

Next	3,000 gallons used per month	\$12.87 per 1,000 gallons
Next	4,000 gallons used per month	\$12.27 per 1,000 gallons
Next	15,000 gallons used per month	\$11.69 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	25,000 gallons used per month	\$ 9.87 per 1,000 gallons

MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than the following, according to the size of the meter installed:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 39.84 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 59.73 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 99.56 per month
1 1/4 inch meter	\$ 145.36 per month
1 1/2 inch meter	\$ 199.12 per month

6 inch meter	\$1,991.17 per month
8 inch meter	\$3,185.87 per month

SCHEDULE III

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

MUNICIPAL EXCISE TAX SURCHARGE

The municipality listed below, having imposed a public utility tax computed on the basis of two percent of revenues from water sales by the District within the corporate limits of such municipality, said tax shall be billed as a surcharge to the customers receiving service within said corporate limits.

The water utility is required to collect the utility tax pursuant to *West Virginia Code §8-13-5a*.

Customers receiving water service within the corporate limits of the specified municipality shall pay a surcharge based on the following surcharge rates:

Municipality: Town of Smithfield Utility Excise Tax 2%

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

RECONNECTION CHARGE - \$20.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of water.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District up to a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

SCHEDULE III (Continued)

TAP FEE

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$350.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the service.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$5.20 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above customer's historical average usage.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of annual billings calculated at the rates in effect at the time the security deposit is calculated and at the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provisions.
