RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable in entire territory served

(C) AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for the general domestic, commercial and industrial service.

(I) RATE

First	2,000 gallons used per month	\$26.00 per thousand gallons
Next	1,000 gallons used per month	\$ 8.68 per thousand gallons
Next	7,000 gallons used per month	\$ 7.47 per thousand gallons
Next	40,000 gallons used per month	\$ 6.46 per thousand gallons
All Over	50,000gallons used per month	\$ 4.57 per thousand gallons

(I) MINIMUM CHARGE

5/8	inch meter	\$ 26.00 per month
3/4	inch meter	\$ 39.05 per month
1	inch meter	\$ 65.08 per month
1	-1/2 inch meter	\$130.15 per month
2	inch meter	\$208.24 per month

(C) DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

Te above schedule is net. On all amounts not paid in full within (21) days of the date of bill, ten percent (10%) charge will be added to the net amount shown. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate

(C,I) VOLUNTARY CONNECTION AND DISCONNECTION FEES

1. The tap fee for each new connection to the system shall be \$300.00 (three hundred dollars) minimum, subject to number two (2) immediately below.
2. The tap fee for each new connection to the system requiring a 1" meter shall be four hundred dollars (\$400.00); for a 1 1/2" meter shall be six hundred (\$600.00); for a 2' or larger meter shall be seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) plus the difference in cost of the subject meter above the standard 3/4" x 5/8" residential meter.

(N) DISCONNECTION FOR NON-PAYMENT OR OTHER CONDITIONS

The water department may disconnect service to any customer for non-payment of his bill, but is first to make diligent effort to induce the customer to pay his bill. A customer who has been notified that water service is to be terminated for non-payment must be provided an opportunity to enter into a reasonable deferred payment plan. The customer has a right to appeal the reasonableness of the plan to the Public Service Commission. In the event a payment is not received on a deferred payment plan, notification before termination of water service is required. Notice requirements for termination of water services are provided for in the Rules and Regulations of the Public Service Commission.

No notice need be given when fraudulent use of water is detected, where the water department's measuring equipment has been tampered with, or where a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's premises. Discontinuance will not be made on Friday, Saturday, Sunday or a day prior to a holiday, or if an emergency exists.

A Twenty-five dollar \$25.00 re-connection fee will be imposed on each such customer, in addition to the water bill and penalties that may be imposed elsewhere in this Tariff, at the time service is restored.

DEPOSIT REQUIRED

Deposits will be handled in accord with Rule 4.02 of the Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities as promulgated by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT INCREMENT

\$1.36 per M. gallons. To be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible water leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such unusual consumption above the customer's historical average usage.
