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

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

- (N) APPLICABILITY  
Applicable within the entire territory served.
- (N) AVAILABILITY  
Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial and sale for resale water service.
- (C,D) RATES  
All gallons used per quarter \$13.22 per 1,000 gallons
- (N) MINIMUM CHARGE  
No bill will be rendered for less than \$6.61 per quarter
- (C) DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY  
The above tariff is net. On all accounts not paid within twenty (20) days, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected once for each bill where it is appropriate.
- (C) RECONNECTION \$25.00  
To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of water.
- (C,I) LEAK ADJUSTMENT  
\$3.05 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historic usage.
- (N) SECURITY DEPOSIT  
Not to exceed one-twelfth (1/12) of the annual estimated charge for residential service or one-sixth of the annual estimated charge for all other service.
