RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Sewerage Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY OF SERVICE

Applicable in areas served by the Village of Barboursville Sanitary Board, West Virginia.

AVAILABILITY

Available for metered general domestic, commercial and industrial service

(I) RATES-METERED WATER USERS

Sewer service shall be based upon all the volume of water delivered to the customer's property. This volume is measured by the water meter serving the premises. In cases where a significant volume of the water delivered to the premises is not returned to the sanitary sewer system or water from another source is discharged to the sanitary sewer system, the customer may request, or the Village Sanitary Board may require, special flow measuring devices to properly measure the volume of wastewater entering the sanitary sewer system. Such special flow measuring devices shall be furnished, installed, and maintained by and at the expense of the customer with the approval of the Village Sanitary Board. In some situations suitable formulae may be used to determine wastewater flow in lieu of special metering devices. Such formulae shall be approved by both the customer and the Village Sanitary Board and subject to the approval of the West Virginia Public Service Commission.

(I) RESIDENTIAL FLAT RATE

Unmetered residential customers will be charged a flat rate of \$28.04 per month which is based on a typical consumption (5,000 gallons).

(I) MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than \$10.58 per month per month (2,000 gallons).

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above tariff is net. On all current usage billings not paid within thirty (30) days, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

Non-payment within sixty (60) days from the due date will result in the Village of Barboursville Sanitary Board effecting such legal remedies as may be available for the collection of the delinquent account.

(N) SECURITY DEPOSIT

A Deposit of \$50.00 is required from all new customers.

SERVICE CONNECTION FEE, RESIDENTIAL

- (1) To apply where an opening for residential connection must be made by the Village Sanitary Board in its collector sewer line or manhole, and a service line laid from such opening to the customer pipe at property line.
- (2) The connection fee shall be \$972.00 when the Village's connection opening, existing sewer or manhole is no further than 50 feet from the customer's connection point pipe at property line.
- (3) When the distance from the Village's connection opening to customers pipe at the property line connection point, exceeds 50 feet, customer will be charged a fee of \$972.00 plus \$17.50 per foot for all service pipe over 50 feet.
- (4) All residential sewer tap applications must be approved by the Sanitary Board before installation.

SERVICE CONNECTION FEE, COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL

- (1) To apply where an opening for commercial or industrial connection must be made by the Village Sanitary Board in its collector sewer line stub out or any manhole. A service line shall be run by the property owner or contractor from the commercial or industrial building to the nearest sewer line stub out or manhole for the sewer connection.
- (2) The connection fee shall be \$972.00 for a commercial or industrial tap. The actual cost will be the charge for the sewer connection by the Village Sanitary Board. The connection will be calculated at the actual cost and the tap fee will be deducted for total amount due.
- (3) The Village Sanitary Board reserves the right to inspect all installation of the sewer line stub out from the building to its connecting point as explained in item number 1. The fees for inspection will be further explained below.
- (4) All commercial sewer tap applications must be approved by the Sanitary Board before installation.

INSPECTION

The Sanitary Board shall inspect all construction work performed relating to extensions of mains and other construction of sanitary facilities, in order to insure that all work performed is in conformance with the Sanitary Board's design and installation requirements. The fee for such inspection services shall be two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) per linear foot of extension inspected. There will also be one hundred and fifty dollar (\$150.00) per manhole inspection fee. Such fee shall be payable to the Sanitary Board by the contractor or other individual primarily responsible for the construction work performed.

WATER DISCONNECTION/RECONNECTION FEES

Whenever water service has been disconnected for non-payment of sewer bill(s) a disconnection fee of \$25.00 shall be charged.

Whenever water service which has been previously disconnected or otherwise withheld for non-payment of sewer bill(s) is reconnected, a reconnection fee of \$25.00 shall be charged.

MOBILE HOMES

A mobile home shall be considered a residential unit for the purposes of this article and shall be subject to all fees and charges provided herein.
