APPLICABILITY

Applicable within entire territory served.

(C) AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial and sale for resale water service.

(C) RATES (Customers with metered water supply)

First	1,000 gallons used per	\$16.54 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	1,000 gallons used per	\$16.54 per 1,000 gallons

(C) MINIMUM CHARGE

No minimum bill will be rendered for less than the following based on meter size:

5/8 inch meter	\$16.54 per month

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

RECONNECTION CHARGE

\$20.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violation of rules, non-payment of bills or fraudulent use of water.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$12.37 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

A deposit of \$50 or two-twelfth (2/12s) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, whichever is greater.

(N) TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$300.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the commission for each new tap to the system.
