

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Sewerage Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial and sale for resale sewer service.

(I) METERED RATES

First	2,000 gallons used per month	\$13.87 per 1,000 gallons
Next	25,000 gallons used per month	\$ 6.32 per 1,000 gallons
Next	75,000 gallons used per month	\$ 5.74 per 1,000 gallons
All over	102,000 gallons used per month	\$ 4.96 per 1,000 gallons

(I,C) MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than \$27.74.

(I) FLAT RATE CHARGE (Customers with non-metered water supply)

Equivalent of 4,500 gallons of water usage or \$43.54 per month

(N) INDUSTRIAL RATE

All wastewater from H.A.M. shall be charged \$7.79 per 1,000 gallons of usage.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

(C) TAP FEE

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant:

A tap fee of \$250.00 will be charged to customers applying for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

(C) RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District not to exceed \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by his or her bank due to insufficient funds.

(N) SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provisions.

(I,C) LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$1.30 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.
