

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.
- II. Each new consumer being supplied with water by the Town of Ridgeley, a municipal corporation, will pay a service connection charge of \$250.00.
- III. If two or more consumers are served by one meter, the total quarterly consumption, as shown by the meter, shall be divided among the number of consumers served by said meter and the rates set out this tariff applied to the amount of water attributed to the use of each of said consumers.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to entire area served

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial service.

(I) RATES

First 2,000 gallons per month	\$33.60
2,000 – 10,000 gallons per month	\$14.14 per 1,000 gallons
All over 10,000 gallons per month	\$ 9.00 per 1,000 gallons

(I) MINIMUM BILL

The above water schedule is subject to a minimum monthly charge of Thirty-three and sixty cents (\$33.60).

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above tariff is net. On all accounts not paid in full within 30 days of the date of bill, 10% will be added to the net amount shown. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is only to be collected once for each bill where it is appropriate.

CONNECTION FEE

A fee of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) shall be charged each new connection to the system.

MULTIPLE OCCUPANCY

Apartment buildings and other multiple occupancy buildings shall be required to have each tenant metered. Hotels and motels shall be exempt from this multiple occupancy charge.

(N) House trailer or mobile home courts served through a single meter shall be required to pay the monthly minimum bill multiplied by the number of units in place at the time the meter is read each month.

DOMESTIC AND COMMERCIAL INDUSTRIAL SECURITY DEPOSITS

A refundable security deposit not to exceed 1/6 of the average annual charge shall be required of commercial and industrial customers prior to being connected or reconnected. Said deposit will be refunded with interest (at a rate provided annually by the Public Service Commission) after 12 consecutive months of on time payments to property owners and to renters after they vacate premise minus any fees due.

(C) DISCONNECT FOR NON-PAYMENT

If any bill is not paid within 60 days from the date of the bill, water service to the customer will be disconnected and will not be restored until all past due bills have been paid in full, together with all penalty charges, subject to applicable rules of the Public Service Commission of West Virginia. Door tags notifying the user(s) of disconnect will cause an additional charge of \$5.00 being applied to the bill.

RECONNECTION SERVICE CHARGE

There shall be a reconnection charge of \$25.00 which shall be paid prior to restoration of water service previously disconnected.

(C) TRANSFER OF SERVICE

Transfer of service from one customer to another including only spouse or executor of state will involve a \$25.00 charge to the new customer for institution of account. All other changes in service require a new deposit of \$145.00 as addressed in security Deposit Section.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

If a check received is returned by the bank for any reason, the bank's charge to the Town shall be the Town's charge to the customer for such returned check and under no circumstances shall the fee collected by the Town exceed \$20.00.
