RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicability within the entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Applicable for general domestic, commercial and industrial service.

(I) RATE

First	2,000 gallons used per month	\$12.50 per 1,000 gallons
All over	2,000 gallons used per month	\$12.04 per 1,000 gallons

(I) MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts according to the size of the meter installed:

5/8 – 3/4 inch meter	\$25.00
1 inch meter	\$37.90

FIRE HYDRANTS

First hydrants rental, each \$93.49 per year.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full within twenty (20) days of date of bill, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net amount shown.

NEW TAP INSTALLATION

The tap installation fee for each new connection to the system shall be four hundred dollars (\$400.00). A new tap and meter will be required for each residence/unit of residence/business.

RECONNECTION FEE \$25.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of water.

(I) Indicates increase

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicants specific customer class, or fifty dollars whichever is greater. This fee may be charged by applicable statutory provisions.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$1.31 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above customer's historical average usage.
