RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial and sale for resale water service.

(I) RATES

First	2,000 gallons used per month	\$ 11.11 per 1,000 gallons
Next	4,000 gallons used per month	\$ 9.74 per 1,000 gallons
Next	4,000 gallons used per month	\$ 6.19 per 1,000 gallons
Next	40,000 gallons used per month	\$ 3.09 per 1,000 gallons
All over	50,000 gallons used per month	\$ 2.98 per 1,000 gallons

(I) MINIMUM BILL

Minimum monthly bill \$22.22

(I) MINIMUM CHARGE

5/8 inch meter	\$ 22.22 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 33.33 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 55.55 per month
1 - 1/4 inch meter	\$ 81.10 per month
1 - 1/2 inch meter	\$ 111.10 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 177.76 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 333.30 per month

RECONNECTION CHARGE

In addition to the requirements that all amounts in arrears, including penalties, be paid prior to reconnection, there shall be a reconnection charge of \$25.00 during business hours (7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.) and \$50.00 at all other times, due and payable prior to reconnection.

TAP FEE

A tap fee will be charged for any new customers requesting service according to the size of the meter as follows:

½ inch, 5/8 inch, and ¾ x ¾ inch	\$ 350.00
over ¾ inch	Cost to be determined based on time and materials involved

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above tariff is net. On all accounts not paid in full within twenty (20) days, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net amount shown. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

SECURITY DEPOSITS

A refundable security deposit of a sum equal to two twelfths of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or \$50, whichever is greater, shall be required of domestic, commercial, and industrial customers prior to being connected or reconnected. Said deposit will be refunded with interest (at a rate provided annually by the Public Service Commission) after 12 consecutive months of on-time payments.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$0.90 per M. gallons. To be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible water leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such unusual consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the City or a maximum of \$30.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by the bank due to insufficient funds.
