RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Sewerage Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within and adjacent to the limits of the District

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for sanitary service in the District

RATE (Based on Water Consumption)

First	2,000 gallons used per month	\$8.72 per 1,000 gallons
Next	28,000 gallons used per month	\$3.69 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	30,000 gallons used per month	\$3.17 per 1,000 gallons

MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than \$17.44 per month (Based on 2,000 gallons).

SURCHARGE

\$2.00 per customer per month until the accumulated debt for unpaid treatment fees, miscellaneous services, and connection costs owed to the City of Dunbar is repaid.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above tariff is net. On all current usage billings not paid within twenty (20) days, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

UNMETERED USERS

These customers will receive a minimum bill.

SERVICE CONNECTION (TAP) FEE

All tap fees	\$300.00

INCREMENTAL COST OF WATER TREATED

\$3.04 per M. Gal to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate is used to calculate consumption above customer's historical average usage.
