RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

STEP 1 RATES

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial and sale for resale water service.

(D) RATES

First 3,000 gallons per month	\$10.27 per 1,000 gallons
Over 3,000 gallons per month	\$10.27 per 1,000 gallons

MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than the following based on meter size:

5/8	inch meter	\$ 27.84 per month
3/4	inch meter	\$ 41.80 per month
1	inch meter	\$ 69.60 per month
1-1/2	inch meter	\$ 139.20 per month
2	inch meter	\$ 222.75 per month
3	inch meter	\$ 417.60 per month
4	inch meter	\$ 696.00 per month
6	inch meter	\$1,392.00 per month
8	inch meter	\$2,227.00 per month

(D) The above minimum charge is subject to an additional \$0.99 per 1,000 gallons of water used.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above tariff is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

STEP 1 RATES (continued)

TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$100.00 will be charged to customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. This pre-construction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of \$350.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

RECONNECTION CHARGE

\$20.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills or fraudulent use of water.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District or a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION (Hydrant or Sprinkler)

2 inch connection	\$ 125.00 per anum
4 inch connection	\$ 375.00 per anum
6 inch connection	\$ 750.00 per anum
8 inch connection	\$1,250.00 per anum
Hose connection 2 1/2 or less	\$ 150.00 per anum
Sprinkler Head	\$ 0.25 per anum

(D) LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$2.37 per 1000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above customer's historical average usage.

STEP 2 RATES

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial and sale for resale water service.

(I) RATES

First 3,000 gallons used per month	\$13.61 per 1,000 gallons
All Over 3,000 gallons used per month	\$13.61 per 1,000 gallons

MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts per month according to meter size installed:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 27.84 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 41.80 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 69.60 per month
1- 1/2 inch meter	\$ 139.20 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 222.75 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 417.60 per month
4 inch meter	\$ 696.00 per month
6 inch meter	\$1,392.00 per month
8 inch meter	\$2,227.00 per month

(I) The above minimum charges are subject to an additional \$4.33 per 1,000 gallons of water used per month.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above tariff is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.
