RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

This schedule shall apply to service in the entire territory served by the water works of the Town of Cairo.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

All water customers served by the water works system of the Town of Cairo, whether for general domestic, commercial or industrial purposes, shall pay in accordance with the schedule established herein.

(I) RATES:

(i) Usage Charge:

- (A) Upon the first 2,000 gallons of water consumed per month, a charge of \$21.53
- (B) Upon the next 3,000 gallons of water consumed per month, a charge of \$10.15 per thousand gallons or any part thereof:
- (C) Upon the next 5,000 gallons of water consumed per month, a charge of \$ 9.53 per thousand gallons or any part thereof;
- (D) Upon the next 10,000 gallons of water consumed per month, a charge of \$ 8.90 per thousand gallons or any part thereof;
- (E) Upon the next 30,000 gallons of water consumed per month, a charge of \$8.56 per thousand gallons or any part thereof;
- (F) Upon all water in excess of 50,000 gallons of water consumed per month, a charge of \$8.06 per thousand gallons, or any part thereof.

(I) (ii) Minimum Charge – No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts, according to the size of the meter installed:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 21.53
3/4 inch meter	\$ 32.30
1 inch meter	\$ 53.83
1 ½ inch meter	\$ 107.65
2 inch meter	\$ 172.24
3 inch meter	\$ 344.48
4 inch meter	\$ 538.25
6 inch meter	\$1,076.50
8 inch meter	\$1,722.40

(I) (iii) Meter Charge: All customers not at present served by the water works system of the Town of Cairo shall, as a condition to being connected to such system, pay a meter charge of \$500.00

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above tariff is net. All accounts not paid in full within 20 days from the date of mailing of monthly bills therefore shall have added the net amount shown a delayed payment penalty of 10% of the amount of such bill.

(I) INCREMENTAL LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$3.15 per M gallons. To be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible water leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate is to be used to calculate consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

(I) RECONNECTION FEE: \$25.00

(I,C) DISCONNECTION

If any bill is not paid within 30 days after the date of the mailing thereof, water service to the customer will be discontinued; provided, however, that at least 24 hours before discontinuation water service, a notice of discontinuation shall be personally served upon the customer by any policeman of the Town of Cairo or the Mayor or the Recorder or any member of the Council, or the same shall be posted in a prominent place upon premises served. Water service will not be restored until all past due water bills have been paid in full and all accrued penalties plus a reconnection charge of \$25.00 shall be paid. A disconnect fee will be charged in the amount of \$25.00 for seasonal customers. If the meter is left in during any period the customer will pay the minimum.

(C) MULTIPLE OCCUPANCY

An apartment building, duplex house, or any other multiple occupancy building, or office building, each unit, family, office or business unit shall be required to pay not less than the minimum monthly charge herein established for a 5/8 inch meter for water. These are \$21.53 each unit per month for water. To determine the charge for multiple occupancy, the number of units in the building at the time the meter is read is to be multiplied by the minimum charge and compared to the use charge based on the actual meter reading; whichever charge is greater shall be used. Motels and hotels shall not be subject to the multiple occupancy charge but will pay according to the size of meter installed.

TRAILER COURTS

The operators of house trailer courts may require separate metering for each sit upon which a house trailer may be set. Alternatively, house trailer courts may be provided with a master meter, in which case the charge for of either (i) the product obtained by multiplying the minimum bill per customer is \$10.00 times the number of units situated on the court site at the time the meter is read, of (ii) the actual charged for water used according to the schedule set forth herein. House trailers, as used herein, shall include both mobile and immobile units. House trailers, either mobile or immobile, located on sites other than a part of a house trailer court shall be billed in the same manner as many other family or business unit.
