RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

SCHEDULE IAPPLICABILITY

Applicable to entire area served with the exception of the Newburg, Fellowsville, York Run, State Route 26/Clinic Waterline Extension.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial and resale water service.

(I) RATES

Town of Newburg direct sales:

<u>Number of Gallons/Month</u>	<u>Rate</u>
First 2,000 gallons	\$9.72 per 1,000 gallons
All over 2,000 gallons	\$9.72 per 1,000 gallons

(I) MINIMUM MONTHLY BILL

No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts, according to size of the meter installed, to wit:

5/8 x 3/4 inch meter	\$ 19.44 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 29.16 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 49.60 per month
1½ inch meter	\$ 97.20 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 155.52 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 291.60 per month
4 inch meter	\$ 486.00 per month
6 inch meter	\$ 972.00 per month
8 inch meter	\$1,555.20 per month

The minimum monthly bill shall be \$19.44 per month for 2,000 gallons.

SCHEDULE I, (Continued)

DELAYED PAYMENT CHARGE

The above tariff is net. On all accounts not paid in full within twenty (20) days of the latest pay date, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

If any bill is not paid within sixty (60) days after date, water service to the customer will be discontinued. Water service will not be restored until all past due water bills have been paid in full and all accrued penalties plus a reconnection charge have been paid.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT INCREMENT

\$1.50 per 1,000 gallons. To be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such unusual consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

(C) CONNECTION CHARGE

A charge of \$250.00 will be made for every new subscriber requiring a new connection for all size meters and connections.

Where new connections involve meters larger than one inch, the new connection will be \$300.00 or actual cost, whichever is greater.

(C) RECONNECTION SERVICE CHARGE

\$25.00 to be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of water.

If service is discontinued at the request of a customer, the Town of Newburg may refuse service to such customer, at the same premises, within eight (8) months, unless said Town shall first receives payment in the amount \$25.00 as a tariff for reconnecting services.

RETURNED CHECKS FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS

If a check received is returned by the bank for any reason, the bank's charge to the Town shall be the Town's charge to the customer for such a bad check, but such charge to the customer shall not exceed \$20.00.

No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts, according to size of the meter installed, to wit:

5/8 x 3/4 inch meter	\$ 24.98 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 37.46 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 62.44 per month
1½ inch meter	\$ 124.88 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 199.80 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 374.63 per month
4 inch meter	\$ 624.38 per month
6 inch meter	\$1,248.75 per month
8 inch meter	\$1,998.00 per month

The minimum monthly bill shall be \$24.98 per month for 2,000 gallons.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT INCREMENT

\$1.56 per 1,000 gallons. To be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such unusual consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

The above tariff is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

If any bill is not paid within sixty (60) days after date, water service to the customer will be discontinued. Water service will not be restored until all past due water bills have been paid in full and all accrued penalties plus a reconnection charge have been paid.

(C) CONNECTION CHARGE

A charge of \$250.00 will be made for every new subscriber requiring a new connection for all size meters and connections.

Where new connections involve meters larger than one inch, the new connection will be \$300.00 or actual cost, whichever is greater.

RECONNECTION SERVICE CHARGE

\$25.00 to be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of water.

If service is discontinued at the request of a customer, the Town of Newburg may refuse service to such customer, at the same premises, within eight (8) months, unless said Town shall first receives payment in the amount \$25.00 as a tariff for reconnecting services.

RETURNED CHECKS FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS

If a check received is returned by the bank for any reason, the bank's charge to the Town shall be the Town's charge to the customer for such a bad check, but such charge to the customer shall not exceed \$20.00.
