POST-CONSTRUCTION TAP FEE

A charge of \$300 will be assessed to customers who connect to the system after completion of constructions adjacent to the customer's property where, in order to connect the customer to the system, a utility service line and meter setting must be installed.

(I) INCREMENTAL COST OF WATER

\$.70 per 1,000 gallons. To be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such unusual consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The company's tariffs are net. On all current usage bills not paid within twenty-one (21) days of the date of bill, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the company, not to exceed \$15.00, will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

RECONNECTION CHARGE

When it has been necessary to discontinue water service to any premises on account of non-payment of any charges for water service, a charge of twenty dollars (\$20.00) will be made to cover the cost of turning on the water service. This charge will not apply where the company has a disconnection agreement with a sewer utility and is entitled to collect a reconnection charge from the sewer utility for such reconnection for non-payment of sewer charges. This charge may be added to a past due balance and included in the outstanding balance under a deferred payment agreement.

BOND SURCHARGE

\$8,150 per month for a period not to exceed the repayment of the WVIJDC loan that the authority received. This surcharge is applicable only to the Stonewall Jackson Resort.

MINIMUM CHARGE

BOND SURCHARGE (Stonewall Jackson Resort)

\$8,150 per month for a period not to exceed the repayment of the WVIJDC loan that the authority received. This surcharge is applicable only to the Stonewall Jackson Resort.
