

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Sewerage Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

STEP 1 RATES

Effective for a period of 27 months

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial sewer service.

(C) RATES

First	2,000 gallons used per month	\$12.15 per 1,000 gallons
Next	3,000 gallons used per month	\$10.71 per 1,000 gallons
Next	5,000 gallons used per month	\$ 7.30 per 1,000 gallons
Next	20,000 gallons used per month	\$ 6.40 per 1,000 gallons
Next	30,000 gallons used per month	\$ 5.78 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	60,000 gallons used per month	\$ 5.43 per 1,000 gallons

FLAT RATE

Equivalent of 3,000 gallons of water usage \$35.01 per month

MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than \$24.30 per month

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all current accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

TAP FEE

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant:

A tap fee of \$200.00 will be charged to customers applying for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

STEP 1 RATES (continued)

DISCONNECT/RECONNECT/ADMINISTRATIVE FEES

Whenever water service has been disconnected for non-payment of sewer bills in conjunction with a water service termination agreement with the West Virginia-American Water Company, a disconnection fee of \$20.00 shall be charged or, in the event the delinquent sewer bill is collected by the water company, an administrative fee of \$20.00 shall be charged.

Whenever water service, which has been previously disconnected or otherwise withheld for non-payment of a sewer bill in conjunction with a water service termination agreement with the West Virginia-American Water Company, is reconnected, a reconnection fee of \$20.00 shall be charged.

TOWN OF ADDISION (Town)

Two percent (2%) Excise Tax on every purchaser of a public utility service within its corporate limits.

This tax was imposed on the municipal users of the District on September 9, 1991.

(C) **RETURNED CHECK CHARGE**

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the sewer utility, not to exceed \$25.00, will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provision.

(I) **INCREMENTAL LEAK ADJUSTMENT**

\$1.16 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above customer's historic average usage.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial sewer service.
