(Effective until November 13, 2019)

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general, domestic, commercial and industrial and sale for resale water service.

(I) **RATES** (Customers with metered water supply)

(I) **MINIMUM CHARGE**

No bill will be rendered for less than the following, based upon meter size:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 34.20 per month

1¼ inch meter	\$ 124.83 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 273.60 per month

The above minimum charges are subject to an additional \$1.49 per 1,000 gallons of water used per month.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

STEP 1 (Continued)**TAP FEE**

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$150.00 will be charged to customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. This pre-construction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of \$300.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

RECONNECTION

\$25.00 - To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violation of rules, non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of water.

(I) LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$5.93 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above customer's historical average usage.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District up to a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or fifty dollars (\$50.00), whichever is greater. This fee may be changed to applicable statutory provisions.
