STEP 1 RATES

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial customers.

(I) **RATES**

First	2,000 gallons used per month	\$ 13.51 per 1,000 gallons
Next	8,000 gallons used per month	\$ 12.72 per 1,000 gallons
Next	10,000 gallons used per month	\$ 9.38 per 1,000 gallons
Next	20,000 gallons used per month	\$ 9.00 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	40,000 gallons used per month	\$ 8.86 per 1,000 gallons

(I) **MINIMUM CHARGE**

No bill will be rendered for less than the following based on meter size:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 27.02 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 40.53 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 67.55 per month
1-1/4 inch meter	\$ 98.62 per month
1-1/2 inch meter	\$ 135.10 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 216.16 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 432.32 per month

STEP 1 RATES, (Continued)

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$100.00 will be charged to customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. This pre-construction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of \$300.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

RECONNECTION

\$25.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violation of rules, non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of water.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the utility, or a maximum of \$25.00, will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

STEP 1 RATES, (Continued)

(I) **LEAK ADJUSTMENT**

\$4.59 per 1,000 gallons of water is to be used when a bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such unusual consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

A deposit of \$50 or two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, whichever is greater.
