

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

**STEP 1 RATES**

**APPLICABILITY**

Applicable within the entire territory served

**AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE**

Available for general domestic, commercial, industrial and sale for resale water service.

**RATES (Customers with metered water supply)**

(C)	First	3,000 gallons used per month	\$12.04 per 1,000 gallons
	Next	3,000 gallons used per month	\$10.22 per 1,000 gallons
	Next	4,000 gallons used per month	\$ 8.74 per 1,000 gallons
	Next	10,000 gallons used per month	\$ 6.10 per 1,000 gallons
	Over	20,000 gallons used per month	\$ 4.44 per 1,000 gallons

**MINIMUM CHARGE**

No bill will be rendered for less than the following based on meter size:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 36.12 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 54.18 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 90.30 per month
1- 1/2 inch meter	\$ 180.60 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 288.96 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 541.80 per month
4 inch meter	\$ 903.00 per month
6 inch meter	\$1,806.00 per month

**TAP FEE**

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$250.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

**STEP 1 RATES (Continued)**

**DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY**

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

**RECONNECTION**

\$20.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, nonpayment of bills or fraudulent use of water.

**(I) LEAK ADJUSTMENT**

\$1.29 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when a bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above customer's historical average usage.

**RETURNED CHECK CHARGE**

A service charge equal to the actual fee assessed to the District or a maximum of twenty-five (\$25.00) will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

**SECURITY AGREEMENT**

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provisions.

**MUNICIPAL EXCISE TAX SURCHARGE**

The municipality listed below having imposed a public utility tax computed on the basis of two percent of the revenue from water sales by Hammond Public Service District within the corporate limits of such municipality, said tax shall be billed as a "surcharge" to the customers receiving service within said corporate limits.

The utility is required to collect the public utility tax pursuant to West Virginia Code Sec. 8-13-5a. Customers receiving water service within the corporate limits of the specified municipality shall pay a surcharge based on the following surcharge rates:
